SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSI)

This sheet and Addendum A are supplements to Appendix S of the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

1.0 Notices to competitors (SI 2)

SSI 1.1 The official online notice board shall be the WhatsApp group *Farr 1020 Champs*.



SSI 1.2 Each Boat must carry 1 each of the following sails: Mainsail, No.1 Genoa, No.2 Genoa, No.1 Spinnaker. Each boat has the option to also carry 1 each of the following No.3 Genoa/Jib, No.2 Spinnaker and Storm Jib. No other sails may be carried.

SSI 1.3 Boats are not required to hold a class measurement certificate. By entering the competitor declares that the boat complies with the Farr 1020 class rules.

2.0 Signals made ashore (SI 4)

SSI 2.1 Signals ashore shall be posted to the WhatsApp group *Farr 1020 Champs*.

SSI 2.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore *1 minute* is replaced with *not less than 45 minutes* in RRS Race Signals AP.

3.0 Schedule of races and class flags (SI 5 & 6)

SSI 3.1 9 races are scheduled for the series:

Day	Date	Scheduled races	Maximum races	First warning
Race Day 1	Saturday 13 th June 2026	5	5	1000hrs
Race Day 2	Sunday 14 th June 2026	4	5	1000hrs

SSI 3.2 The Farr 1020 class flag is Dark Blue.

SSI 3.3 On Sunday 14th June no warning signal will be made after 1500.

4.0 Courses (SI 7)

SSI 4.1 The courses to be sailed, the order in which the marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left are shown in Addendum A.

SSI 4.2 In the event that a gate mark is missing and has not been replaced with an object displaying flag M, the remaining mark shall be rounded to port.

5.0 Marks (SI 8)

SSI 5.1 The description of the marks is in the table in Addendum A.

6.0 The start (SI 9)

SSI 6.1 A boat starting later than four minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and 5.2.

SSI 6.2 If any part of a boat's hull, crew or equipment is on the course side of the starting line at the start signal, the race committee may attempt to broadcast her name and/or sail number on VHF channel 04. Failure to make a broadcast will not be grounds for a request for redress. This changes rule 61.4(b)(1).

7.0 Time limits and target times (SI 12)

8.0 Penalties at the time of an incident (RRS 44)

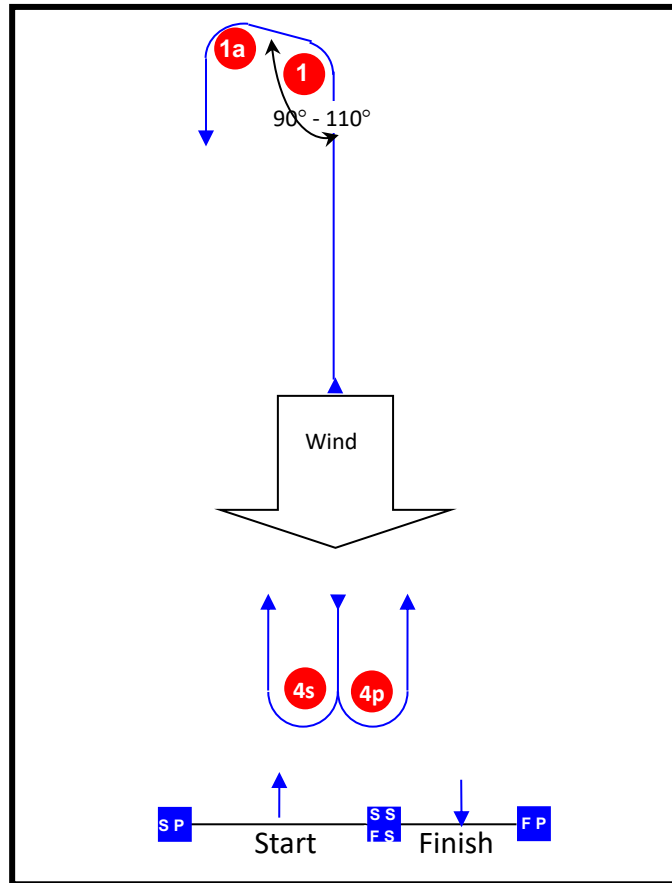
SSI 8.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

LA1	Numeral pennant 1	Start – 1 – 1a – Finish
LA2	No signal	Start – 1 – 1a – 4s/4p – 1 – 1a – Finish

Mark	Description
1 1	Orange triangular buoy
1a 1a	Orange teardrop buoy
4s 4p 4s 4p	Yellow triangular buoys
SS Starting mark starboard end	Staff displaying Orange flag on race committee vessel
SP Starting mark port end	Tall red cylinder
Change of course	Large black cylinder
FS Finishing mark starboard end	Staff displaying Blue flag on race committee vessel
FP Finishing mark port end	Red/Orange teardrop buoy
